

CFB Scholarships - 2026 Information

For 2026 there are 2 CFB Scholarships offered for post-secondary students. First place is \$2,000. Second place is \$1,500.

To be an eligible applicant:

- You must have qualified for & be competing at the 2026 CFB on August 30, 2026
- You must be enrolled in a minimum two-year program at an accredited post-secondary educational institution
- You must be enrolled in & attending the Fall 2026 Semester of post-secondary studies
- You must be a Canadian Citizen
- You must email the application form & proof of enrollment, before the deadline of August 25, 2026 at 7 pm, to CFBroping@gmail.com

CFB reserves the right to modify the scholarship process at any time.

After you send in the application form, then we will email back and confirm if you are eligible. The list of contestants that are eligible applicants will be posted at the office.

Ranch Hand Last Chance Roping

If you are entering the Ranch Hand Last Chance Roping on Aug 29 (and trying to win CFB spots at this roping), then you still need to submit the application form before the Aug 25 deadline.

Awarding of Scholarships

From the eligible applicants, the awarding of scholarships will be determined based on roping results from the CFB Event on August 30, 2026. The highest-placing eligible applicant, will receive the \$2,000 scholarship. The second highest-placing eligible applicant will receive the \$1,500 scholarship.

The highest-placing will be determined by

1. Fastest time in the final Top 5 Round. If there is no eligible applicant in this round then
2. Fastest time in the final Top 10 Round. If there is no eligible applicant in this round then
3. Fastest time in the final Top 20 Round. If there is no eligible applicant in this round then
4. Fastest average time from Round 1 and Round 2.

Additional Info

- Each eligible applicant can only receive one scholarship.
- Any ties will be broken by the preceding round. For example, if two eligible applicants had a NT in the Top 10 Round, then this tie would be broke by the fastest time in the Top 20 Round.
- Eligible applicants must have a qualified time at the event to be awarded a scholarship. If eligible applicants do not get qualified times, then we will either not award the scholarships or consider doing a rope-off, and this is at the sole discretion of CFB.
