

2026 - Sponsored Ropers Information

We have been consistently asked: "How can I help with the CFB Event?"

Here is your chance to help make the event great with a larger payout!

*If we get 20 Sponsored Ropers, then that would mean roping for **\$25,000 Added Money!***

There are 20 Spots reserved for ropers that bring in a sponsorship to CFB. Read the following details about how it works and contact CFB if you have any questions.

- 1) There is a one-page form called "CFB Sponsor a Roper". You will need to put your Name, Phone Number and Email on this form and then give it to the business that you are asking to sponsor.
- 2) The business is to return the form back to you, and then you submit the form to CFBroping@gmail.com
- 3) The deadline to submit the form & payment is August 17 @ Noon or when the 20 Spots are filled, whichever is first. Forms can be submitted starting on April 17.
- 4) Submission of the sponsorship form and/or payment does not guarantee that you will get a Spot. There are only 20 Spots reserved for Sponsored Ropers. Once those 20 Spots are filled, then there are no more Spots available. That means that you, the breakaway roper, are responsible for keeping up-to-date on whether there are spots left or not. It will be updated regularly on the CFB website, stating how many spots are left. Do not submit the form if the 20 Spots have already been filled.
- 5) The CFB website will be updated with the list of ropers that have been awarded a Spot as a Sponsored Roper. After the form and payment is received, then CFB confirms if a roper is eligible for a Spot, and then a roper will be added to this list on the website.
- 6) A roper can be awarded a maximum of 2 CFB Spots. These could be from the same category or different categories (e.g. 1 Spot as a Sponsored Roper and 1 Spot from a CFB Qualifier).
- 7) You must be a Canadian citizen to be eligible for a Sponsored Roper Spot. A non-citizen is eligible for a Sponsored Roper Spot if they have entered the CFB Sidepot at a CFB Qualifier in either 2024 or 2025. To clarify, you are not required to be a Canadian citizen for Spots at CFB through the other qualification categories. A non-citizen could get a Spot in the categories of: Invited Roper, CFB Qualifiers or Ranch Hand Last Chance Roping. If you are unsure if you are eligible for a Spot as a Sponsored Roper then please contact the CFB Office.
- 8) This is the first year for this new way to qualify and we hope it goes smoothly. We reserve the right to modify these rules for Sponsored Ropers, at any time. We reserve the right to refuse any sponsorship form and not award a Spot to any roper, for any reason. In the event of a sponsorship form being refused, if payment had been received, then we will return that payment to the sponsor.
